CONFESSIONS & PRAYER POINTS

1. Father, release the wisdom necessary to carry double without destroying what You have placed in my hands! Give me wisdom for increase, expansion, influence, and stewardship! (Proverbs 4:7; Luke 16:10)
2. I decree that my season of shame will not become my identity! According to the Word of the Lord, shame shall be exchanged for DOUBLE and confusion for rejoicing! (Isaiah 61:7)
3. Every devourer assigned against my harvest, resources, opportunities, and increase, I rebuke your operation! My harvest shall reach my hands! (Malachi 3:10–11)
4. My Father, my God, enlarge my capacity before You enlarge my portion! Stretch my faith, strengthen my character, increase my wisdom, and prepare me to carry MORE! (Isaiah 54:2–3)
5. Every limitation that has declared, “This is as far as you will go,” break now! I receive grace to enlarge, stretch forth, lengthen, strengthen, and possess! (Isaiah 54:2–3)
6. Father, where dishonor attempted to mark my name, establish Your honor upon my life! Let the exchange of Isaiah 61 manifest: DOUBLE for shame and everlasting joy for confusion! (Isaiah 61:7)
7. My Father, render DOUBLE according to Your promise! Let every place that looked barren become evidence that You are the God of restoration! (Zechariah 9:12)
8. I break agreement with small thinking, survival thinking, and fear of increase! I receive the faith to believe God for exceedingly abundantly above what I can ask or think! (Ephesians 3:20)
9. Every inherited pattern of loss, starting over, almost having it, and watching opportunities disappear, I refuse to reproduce you in my future! I move forward under the blessing and direction of God! (Galatians 3:13–14)
10. Father, give me the double-portion mentality of Elisha! Give me holy hunger to carry everything necessary to fulfill the assignment You have placed upon my life! (2 Kings 2:9)
11. Every door God has opened before me, remain OPEN! No opposition, intimidation, delay, or resistance will cause me to abandon what God has appointed for me! (Revelation 3:7–8)
12. My Father, my God, restore opportunities I thought were permanently lost! Redeem time, restore wasted years, and cause purpose to arise from places where I experienced disappointment! (Joel 2:25; Ephesians 5:16)
13. I decree DOUBLE fruitfulness over every seed God instructed me to sow! My labor in the Lord shall not be empty, wasted, or without fruit! (1 Corinthians 15:58; Galatians 6:9)
14. Father, establish me in the place You have appointed for me! Plant me where I can flourish, build, produce, and fulfill Your purpose without being uprooted by fear! (Psalm 1:3; 2 Samuel 7:10)

19. MY FATHER, MY GOD, I STAND UPON ISAIAH 61:7! FOR EVERY SHAME, I RECEIVE DOUBLE; FOR EVERY CONFUSION, I RECEIVE REJOICING; AND IN THE LAND YOU HAVE APPOINTED FOR ME, I SHALL POSSESS THE DOUBLE! I WILL NOT DIE OUTSIDE MY PROMISE, I WILL NOT ABANDON MY PORTION, AND I WILL NOT SETTLE FOR LESS THAN WHAT YOU HAVE ORDAINED. Hebrew

- **Mishneh** - Strong's H4932
- **Meaning:** double, second, repetition, second portion, twice as much.
- **It comes from שָׁנָה (shanah, H8138), meaning to repeat, do again, change, or do a second time.**
- **Isaiah 61:7 KJV.... Deuteronomy 21:17 KJV**
- **Kephal / Kephel**
- **Meaning:** double, doubling, twofold.
- **It comes from כָּפַל (kaphal, H3717), meaning to double, fold together, or multiply by doubling.**
- **Job 11:6 KJV... Job 41:13 KJV**

Greek

- **Diploous** - Strong's G1362
- **Meaning:** double, twofold, twice as much.
- **It is related to the idea of something being twofold rather than single.**
- **Matthew 23:15 KJV**
- **Diploō** - Strong's G1363
- **Meaning:** to double, repay double, render twice as much.
- **This is the action word. Diploous describes something as double; diploō describes the act of making, giving, or repaying it double.**
- **Revelation 18:6 KJV**

LEXICAL AIDE

- **Lexical Aid:** Mishneh carries the concept of a repetition, second occurrence, duplicate, second portion, or double amount. In inheritance language, it can describe the double portion belonging to the firstborn. In Isaiah 61:7, the emphasis is on receiving a double portion in place of former shame and confusion.

Prayer is where we come into agreement with what God has spoken concerning our lives. When God declares double, prayer becomes the place where we contend in faith for the fulfillment of His Word. Isaiah 61:7 KJV declares, “For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.” Notice the language: possess the double. God was speaking to people who had experienced shame, loss, and disruption, yet their history would not determine their portion. Prayer keeps our hearts anchored to the promise while we move from what we have experienced into what God has declared.

There are seasons when prayer is about asking, and there are seasons when prayer becomes persistent agreement with the Word of God. Hannah prayed until the condition that had caused her grief was changed. She entered prayer barren, but God answered her with Samuel, and afterward she became the mother of additional children. 1 Samuel 2:21 KJV says, “And the LORD visited Hannah, so that she conceived, and bare three sons and two daughters.” Her story reminds us that an answer from God can become the doorway into something greater than the original request. Double requires us to keep praying even when we have already seen evidence that God is moving.

Job gives us another picture of prayer connected to double restoration. Job 42:10 KJV says, “And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.” Job had endured tremendous loss, yet loss did not get the final word over his life. His restoration appears in the same verse as his prayer. This does not establish a formula that praying for others automatically produces twice as much materially, but it reveals something powerful: God is able to bring restoration on the other side of devastating loss, and prayer remains part of our posture while He does it.

Prayer for double must also be accompanied by the faith to receive and steward a greater portion. Elisha asked Elijah in 2 Kings 2:9 KJV, “I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.” His request was connected to inheritance and calling. He was asking for the portion necessary to carry what God had placed before him. That means our prayer cannot stop at, “Lord, give me more.” We must also pray, “Lord, make me ready for what I am asking You to entrust to me.” Double responsibility may accompany double opportunity. Double influence requires deeper character. Double resources require greater stewardship. We should have the capacity to carry what we have the faith to request.

So this week, pray with expectation for the double. Pray over the places where there has been shame, delay, loss, disappointment, and warfare, and place those areas underneath the promises of God. Zechariah 9:12 KJV declares, “Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of hope: even to day do I declare that I will render double unto thee.” Become a prisoner of hope, someone whose expectation refuses to escape from what God has said. Pray until fear loses its voice. Pray until your heart agrees with the promise. Pray for wisdom to steward the answer. Pray for capacity to carry the increase. And when God opens the door, walk through it prepared to possess the portion He has appointed for you.
