WORD OF THE WEEK

Hebrew

- תפילה (Tefillah) Strong's H8605
- Meaning: Prayer, Supplication, Intercession, A plea made before God, An act of worship and communion with God

- Root Word: 779 (Palal) Strong's H6419
- Meaning: To pray, To intervene, To intercede, To judge oneself before God, To make a request before a superior authority

- Lexical Insight:
- The Hebrew concept of prayer carries the idea of coming before God for self-examination, intercession, communion, and alignment with His will. Prayer in Hebrew involves the heart being adjusted and brought into agreement with God's purposes.
- Example: "Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry." (Psalm 39:12 KJV)

Greek

- προσευχή (Proseuche) Strong's G4335
- Meaning: Prayer addressed to God, Worship through prayer, Earnest communication with God, A petition or request made to God
- προσεύχομαι (Proseuchomai) Strong's G4336
- Meaning: To pray, To worship through prayer, To make requests to God, to devote oneself to prayer, "To move toward God with a desire, petition, vow, or devotion."
- Lexical Insight: the Greek understanding emphasizes drawing near to God in reverence and devotion. Prayer is not merely speaking; it is approaching God, expressing dependence upon Him, and maintaining fellowship with Him.
- Example: "Pray without ceasing." (1 Thessalonians 5:17 KJV)

Webster's Dictionary Definition

Prayer (noun)

1. An address, petition, or communication made to God or a deity.
2. A solemn request for help, guidance, mercy, protection, or thanksgiving.
3. An act of worship involving adoration, confession, thanksgiving, and supplication.
4. Earnest entreaty or sincere request.

9. I refuse shallow fellowship with God. I pursue deeper communion, greater revelation, and stronger intimacy with the Holy Spirit. Philippians 3:10, Jeremiah 29:13
10. My life will not be governed by emotions, circumstances, or pressure. My decisions will be birthed from prayer and obedience to God. Isaiah 30:21, James 1:5
11. I break agreement with distraction, inconsistency, and spiritual drift. My heart is fixed and established before the Lord. Psalm 57:7, Colossians 4:2
12. I will stand in the gap for my family, church, city, and nation until God's purposes are established. Ezekiel 22:30, Isaiah 62:6-7
13. I refuse to carry burdens in my flesh that belong on the altar. Every care, anxiety, and concern is surrendered to God in prayer. 1 Peter 5:7, Philippians 4:6-7
14. I reject spiritual passivity. I will contend in prayer until what God has spoken manifests in the earth. Daniel 10:12-13, Luke 18:1
15. I will not become weary in prayer. I will continue seeking, asking, knocking, and believing until breakthrough comes. Luke 11:9-10, Galatians 6:9
16. I refuse to pray empty words. My prayers will be rooted in Scripture, faith, obedience, and the will of God. John 15:7, 1 John 5:14
17. I submit my will, desires, ambitions, and plans to God's purposes. His will shall govern my life. Luke 22:42, Romans 12:2
18. I reject every hardened area of my heart. Prayer will continually keep me humble, teachable, and sensitive to God's voice. Psalm 139:23-24, Hebrews 3:15
19. I will seek God before seeking solutions. I will pursue His presence before pursuing His provision. Matthew 6:33, Psalm 63:1
20. I choose the secret place over public recognition. I desire God's approval more than man's applause. Matthew 6:6, Psalm 91:1
21. I refuse to allow disappointment, delay, or unanswered prayers to silence my pursuit of God. Habakkuk 2:3, Romans 12:12
22. I will pray until my mind is renewed, my heart is transformed, and my life reflects the nature of Christ. Romans 12:2, 2 Corinthians 3:18
23. I take my place as a watchman and will remain alert to what God is saying and doing in this hour. Isaiah 62:6, Habakkuk 2:1
24. I reject every counterfeit source of strength. My help, wisdom, and direction come from the Lord alone. Psalm 121:1-2, Isaiah 40:31
